

Ambedkar University Delhi Guidelines for Persons with Disability

In compliance with the Office Memorandum issued on 22/07/2020 by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Government of India, particularly in the context of pandemic (COVID-19) situation, Ambedkar University Delhi has adhered the following guidelines for the Persons with Disabilities appearing for various Post-Graduate entrance examinations.

Persons with disability of 40% or more opted for his or her own scribe for marking responses (answers) on their behalf, has to produce original medical certificate issued by competent medical authority regarding such disability at the time of entry to the examination centre. All the candidates with disabilities will be allowed “compensatory time” of 20 minutes per hour. A scribe declaration form is available on the AUD website, which is to be downloaded, filled and brought to the examination centre along with admit card on the day of examination.
